Supplies

Beads: This project calls for transparent 4 mm round faceted beads.

The approximate number and the color of beads needed are listed in the table below the pattern.

Uses 3 out of 16 colors.

Color names may vary by suppliers, the colors in the table are the names used by The Beadery®. I highly recommend their beads.

String: You will want to have about 15 yds. of 12 lb. (or 10 lb.) test clear monofilament fishing line on hand.

General Needs: Fingernail Clippers, Pencil, Ruler and Organizer.

Hanging your finished product, I recommend 2 small suction cups with hooks. The hook will easily fit between the beads. Place one on each end of your work and hang it in the window of your choice.

Stitch: Right Angle Weave (I prefer the 2 needle technique, but the 1 needle works also.)

This pattern is worked diagonally. Starting at the bottom right-hand corner you will work your way to the top left-hand corner.
